



What Can I Do to Make a Difference?

- Print and pass out NCC4CR cards
- Educate friends, family, and co-workers about this movement
- Bring people to meetings
- Send people to the NCC4CR website to “join”
- Start a group meeting in your home or place of business

How Can I Recruit Others to Join?

- Leave NCC4CR cards everywhere you go—teller tubes at the bank, grocery stores, park benches, etc.
- Hand out NCC4CR cards to those in public who are not wearing masks
- Leave NCC4CR cards on the doorstep of homes flying American flags or displaying Trump yard signs
- Attend County Commissioner meetings, City Council meetings, and other Government gatherings where masks and related issues are discussed
- Attend a rally and/or a protest
- Talk to business owners who are not enforcing masks in their establishments
- Talk with pastors and ministers who do not enforce mask wearing and social distancing

How Would I Organize My Own Meeting?

- Invite family, friends, neighbors and co-workers who do not support the Governor’s Executive Order
- Meetings can be held anywhere—in homes, businesses, churches, restaurants with meeting areas, gyms, community centers—or anywhere there is space to place folding chairs
- Meet for one hour on a regular basis
- Follow a simple agenda: dessert/mingle, share NCC4CR mission-goals, state why you are involved, discuss real-life examples of state government overreach, share website
- If there are limitations on gatherings, remember peaceful protests and political speeches are permitted even during a “pandemic.” You can post that you are having a peaceful protest if you have any issues with local officials.
